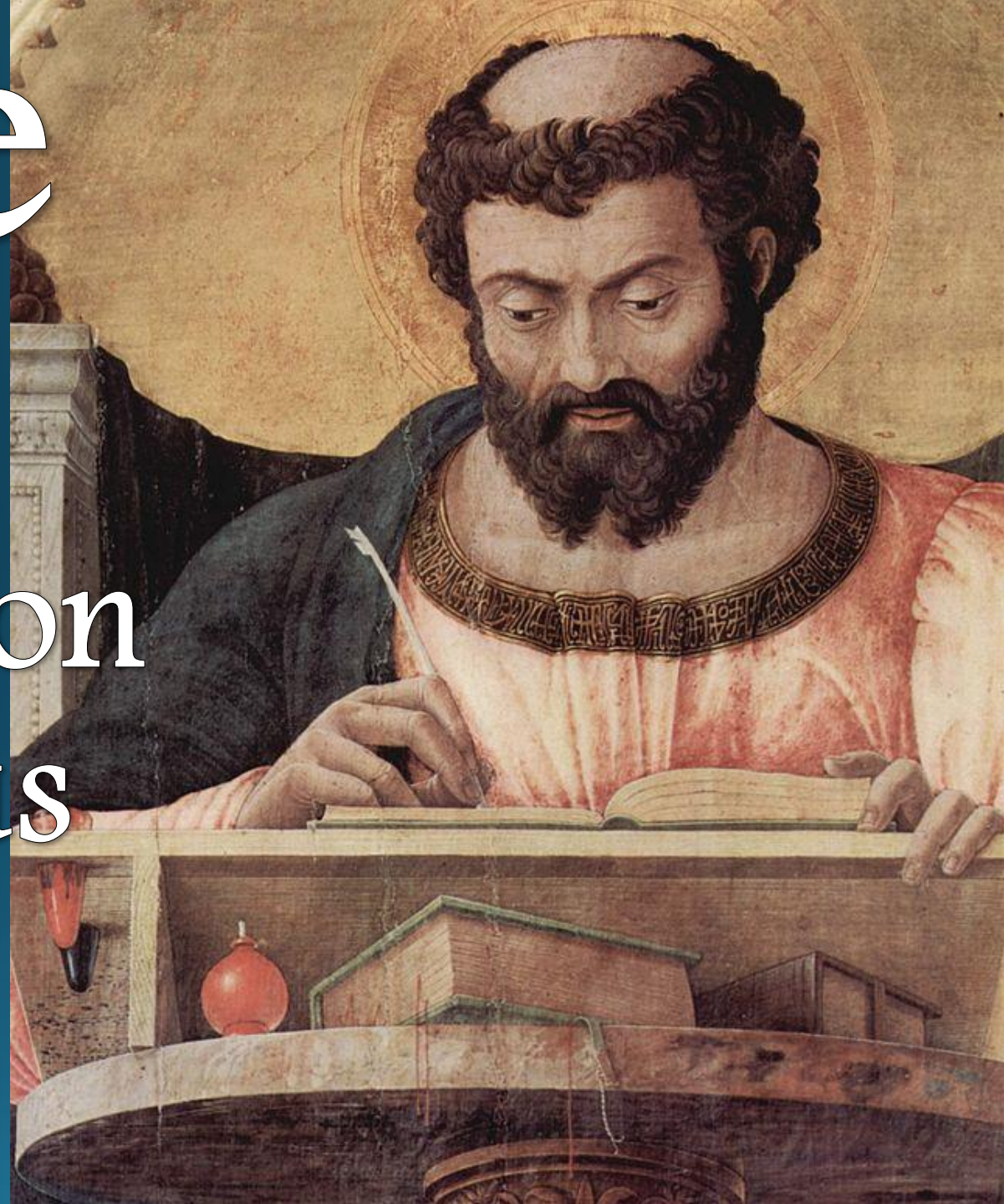

# Person and Example of Jesus

- God confirms Jesus and His ministry with an audible voice at His baptism (3:21–22)
- Jesus' genealogy establishes Him as the physical and legal heir to David's throne and connects Him to all humankind through the mention of Adam (3:23–38)
- The Holy Spirit led Jesus into a confrontation with the devil (4:1–2)

# Person and Example of Jesus

- The devil employed a variety of “lures” when trying to tempt Jesus (4:3–13)
- Jesus successfully resisted temptation through His knowledge of and obedience to God’s Word (4:3–13)

# Putting it into Practice

- Accept Jesus as the only way to get to God (3:22; John 14:6; Acts 4:12)
- Recognize that tests in life give us an opportunity to grow (Jam 1:2-4)
- Develop a “memory bank” of Scripture that gives us the knowledge we need to live faithfully (Ps 119:11)
- Fix our eyes on the benefit that comes from being dedicated to God and His will (Matt 25:21; 1 John 2:28)
