





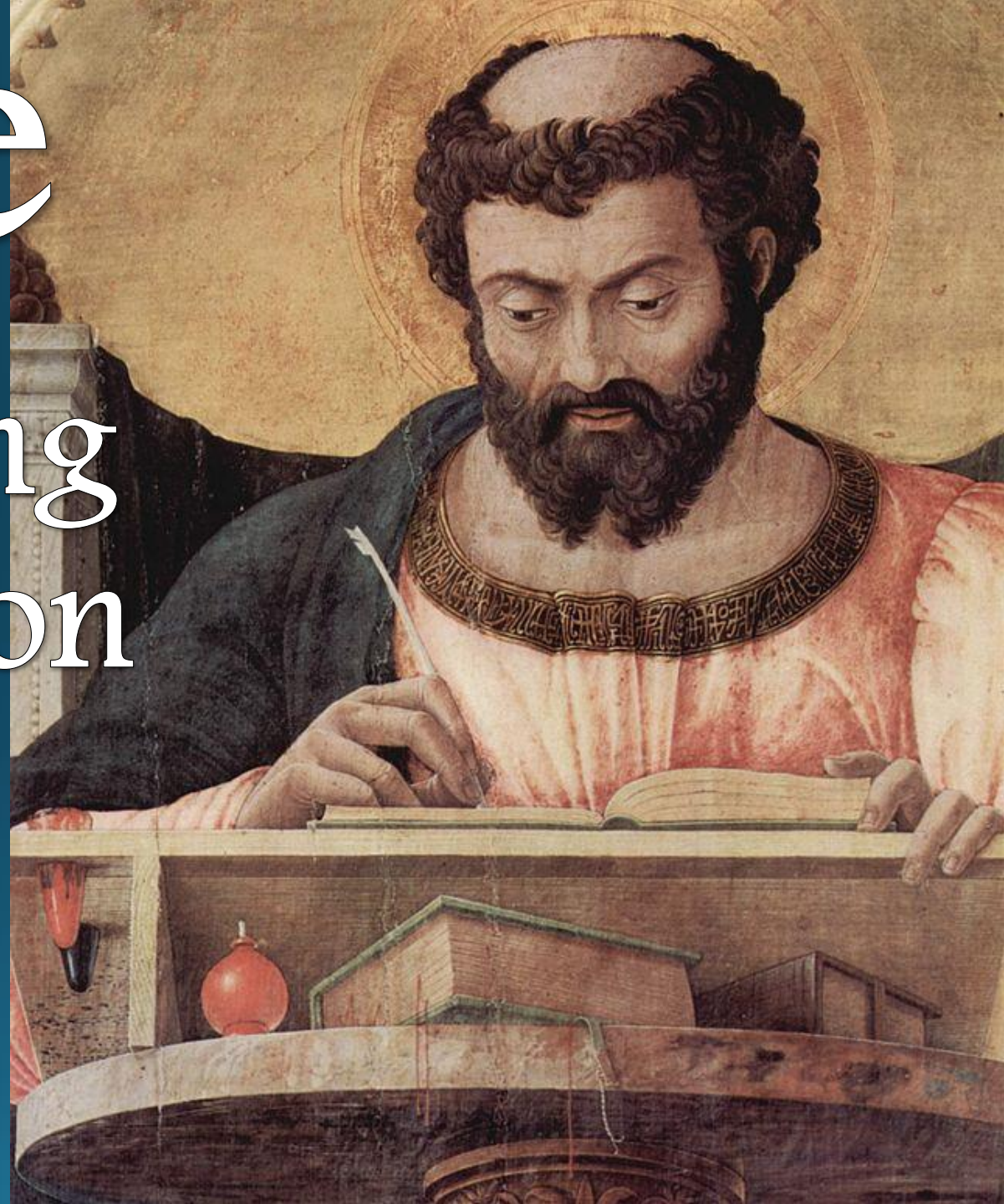

Luke 5:33–6:11



When Traditions Hinder...

- It is all too easy to make human traditions more important than God's intention (5:33, 6:2, 6:7; cf. Mark 2:27, 3:5)
- Jesus brings a new approach for relating to God (5:36–38)
- Our natural resistance to change often makes it difficult for us to embrace God's priorities (5:39, 6:11)

Putting it into Practice

- Prepare ourselves to be “renewed in mind” by Bible study (Rom 12:2; cf. Luke 6:3)
 - Have the right attitude
 - Have the right practice
 - Have the right process
- Be careful that our zeal to “be right” does not overshadow compassion for people (Luke 6:3, 9)
