The Response of Faith

- God wants His people to see <u>potential</u> for <u>change</u> instead of dwelling on present and past <u>failure</u> (7:36–39)
- God's grace and forgiveness is what prompts sinners to respond with love and devotion (7:40–43)
- Faith expresses itself through concrete action (7:44–48; 8:1–3)
