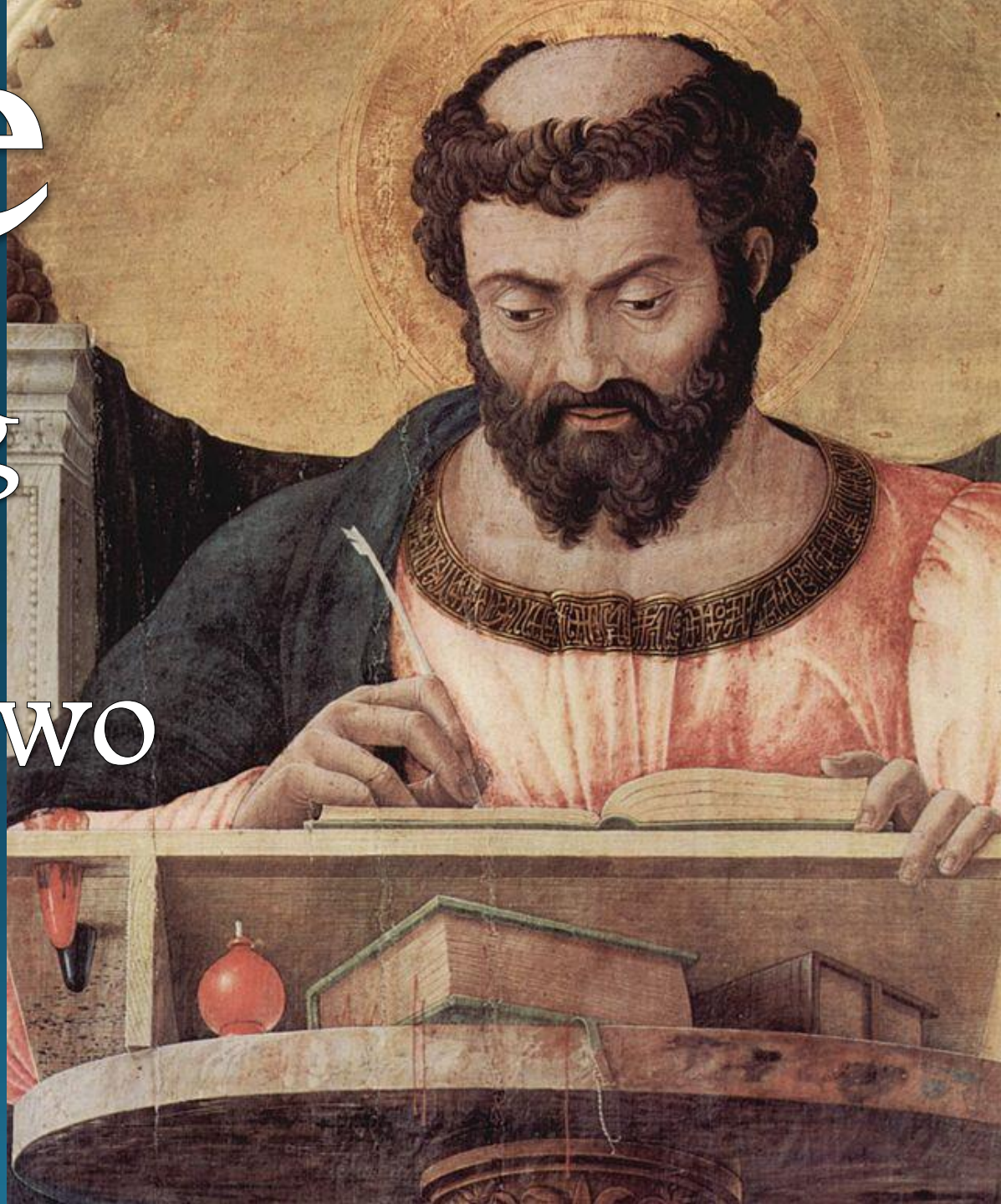

# The Privilege of Partnership

- Jesus' mission is not restricted to a select few (v.1)
- God makes every Christian a laborer for His mission (vv. 2–9)
- Christ's mission proclaims an ultimate reality that is either accepted (resulting in blessing) or rejected (resulting in judgment) (vv. 10–16)
- Engaging in Christ's mission is an exhilarating experience (vv. 17–20)

# The Privilege of Partnership

- All it takes to engage in Christ's mission is simple faith (vv. 21-24)

# Putting it into Practice

- Evaluate whether are living as if Christ and His kingdom is central to our life purpose
- Engage in daily prayer, meditation, and Bible reading to remain mindful of Christ and His mission
- Let our relationship with Christ break in to daily life
