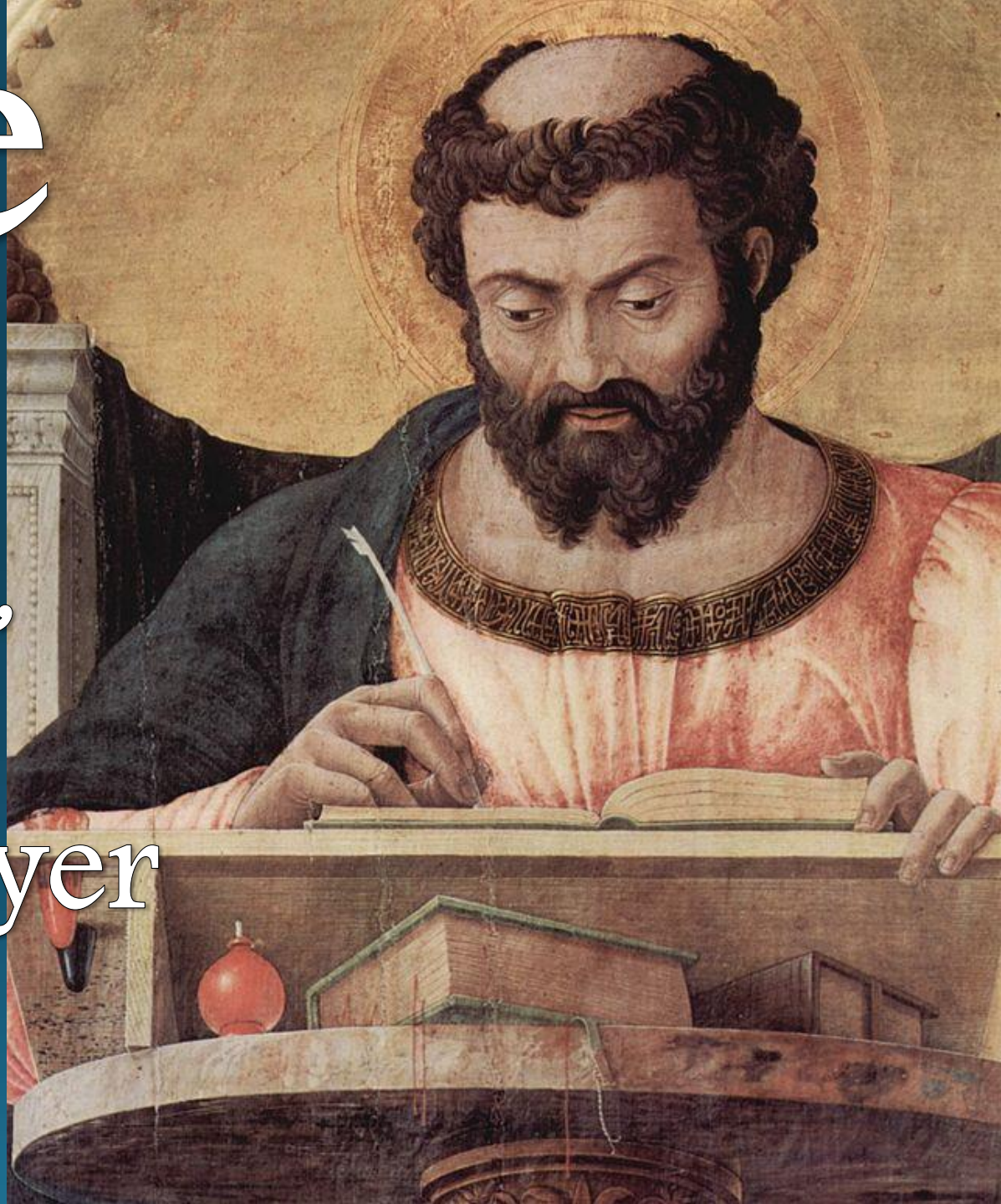

Our Relationship with God

- We must be careful not to let the concerns of this life keep us from listening to God's Word (10:38-40)
- We must be careful not to judge others when they make a choice to relate to God differently than we do (10:40-42)
- Jesus' model prayer illustrates right kinds of concerns we should pray about, not the exact wording of a prayer (11:1-4)

Our Relationship with God

- We can bring our requests before God with boldness, because God has a tender concern for His children (1 1:5–13)

Putting it into Practice

- Make a consistent, daily appointment to “sit at the feet of Jesus” through Bible reading, study, and prayer
- Consider our S.H.A.P.E and identify how God’s name can be “made holy” and His kingdom can advance through our actions
 - Spiritual gifts
 - Heart
 - Abilities and talents
 - Personality
 - Experience

Putting it into Practice

- Arrange our prayers—and our priorities—according to Jesus' example: His kingdom, our needs, then our wants
